A.BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves and adopts the 2015/2016 school budget in the amount of \$53,461,648.

B. WHEREAS, at the Annual Budget Vote and Election held on May 18, 2010, the District voters authorized the expenditure of no more than One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000) from the previously established Capital Reserve Fund #1 for a capital project involving district-wide improvements, and

WHEREAS, at the Annual Budget Vote and Election held on May 15, 2012, the District voters authorized the expenditure of no more than Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) from the previously established Capital Reserve Fund #1 for a capital project involving repairs to the high school roof, and

WHEREAS, the said capital projects have been completed at a total cost of Two Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand One Hundred Eighty Five Dollars and Thirty Six cents (\$239,185.36) leaving an unexpended balance in the amount of One Million One Hundred Sixty Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Sixty Four Cents (\$1,160,814.64) remaining from the originally authorized expenditure, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board acknowledges saving of the aforesaid sum of One Million One Hundred Sixty Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen and 64/100 Dollars (\$1,160,814.64) from the total amount authorized to be expended in connection with the completed capital projects, and be it further

RESOLVED that Administration be and hereby is authorized and directed to return the aforesaid unexpended balance of One Million One Hundred Sixty Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen and 64/100 Dollars (\$1,160,814.64) to the established Capital Reserve Fund #1.

C. BOARD RESOLUTION TO AMEND AUTHORIZATION TO EXPEND CAPITAL RESERVE FUNDS

WHEREAS, by resolution dated March 24, 2015, the

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Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District ("Board") authorized and directed that a proposition be presented before the voters at the Annual District Meeting to undertake certain capital improvements and construction work at District buildings and/or facilities during the 2015-16 school year, and to expend available funds from the District's Capital Reserve Fund II for that purpose, at no additional cost to the District's taxpayers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby amends said proposition to authorize the expenditure of available remaining funds from the District's Capital Reserve Fund I for that purpose, at no additional cost to the District's taxpayers, as follows:

<u>PROPOSITION NO. 2 (Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure Proposition):</u>

RESOLVED: that the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District ("District") be hereby authorized to appropriate and expend from the District's Capital Reserve Fund I, heretofore established by the voters of the District on May 19, 2009, an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Sixty Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen and 64/100 Dollars (\$1,160,814.64), and from District's Capital Reserve Fund II, heretofore established by the voters of the District on May 20, 2014, an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000.00), to undertake and perform the following school building improvements, renovations and/or alterations to commence during the 2015-16 school year ("Project"), substantially as described in a memorandum report prepared by the District's architects ("Report"), on file and available for public inspection in the office of the District Clerk, all at no additional cost to District taxpayers: replacement of windows, bathroom upgrades, and installation of stadium lights at the High School, final phase of roof replacement, bathroom upgrades. and installation of auditorium air conditioning at the Middle School, roof replacement, window replacement, masonry repairs, and bathroom upgrades at the Davison School, bathroom upgrades, and basement ventilation at the Downing School, and the replacement of the mini bus, and the sites thereof, including and where necessary) furnishings. equipment, machinery, demolition and other work required in connection therewith or incidental thereto; provided that the costs of the components of the Project as set forth in the Report may be reallocated among such components if the Board of Education shall Approval of Contract renewal with G. BE IT FURTHER, RESOLVED, that the district clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to substitute the above revised PROPOSITION NO. 2 in lieu of that previously included in the legal notice for the 2015 Annual District Budget Vote and Election in any subsequent publications of said legal notice, which said amended legal notice shall be designated as such, and shall be published, in addition to those publication dates already anticipated, on such additional dates as may be required to ensure that the said amended legal notice is published in each of the newspapers designated by the District, at least once during each of the four weeks preceding the date of the vote.

D. BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District approves the contract renewal with G. Scott Designs, Inc., to provide Theatrical Sound, Lighting & Stage Rigging (Repair & Replacement), for the 2015-2016 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Board President to execute said contract.

E. BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District approves the contract renewal with Parsons Commercial LLC, to provide Carpet & Tile Installation, for the 2015-2016 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Board President to execute said contract.

F. BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board agrees to engage the firm of School Aid Specialists, LLC to provide state aid recovery services pursuant to the terms and conditions of a certain Service Agreement and Rider thereto, and
